Abbie writes: When I was little, my mom used to burst into my room on Saturday mornings singing "Awake awake ye sleepers, the sun is in the sky..." I could never resist singing a round (I still can't), so she knew I was awake if I started singing with her.

I still love rounds so much I apparently write them in my sleep! I woke up with "Morning Round" singing itself to me on a crisp fall morning as the sun streamed into my window. I later realized it fit *almost* perfectly as a double-canon with "Awake, Awake, Ye Sleepers." (I changed one note from the original so they'd fit together.)

Here are both rounds, side-by-side, so you can try them out together or apart.
