PERFORMANCE NOTES

All

- sh—>ff represents spoken, unpitched white noise. For the full duration of the arrow, transform an unpitched “sh” sound into “ff” gradually over several beats. Visit daletrumbore.com/measured-sands for a reference recording.
- x noteheads indicate unpitched vocables.

Singers

- A dotted line indicated the illusion of a continued line (no audible breath), with a consonant cutoff landing on the rest.
- Parentheses () indicate that a note can be omitted if out of range.

Cello

- o indicates a natural harmonic, notated at pitch.
- + indicates left hand pizzicato.

Piano

- Grey rests indicate duration of beats, not silence.
- Boxed notes should be played first as written, then in any order, rippling quickly, ebbing and flowing gently in speed, approximately between the speed of 16th notes and 8th notes.

Harp

- Boxed notes (bisbigliando) should be played first as written, then in any order.
