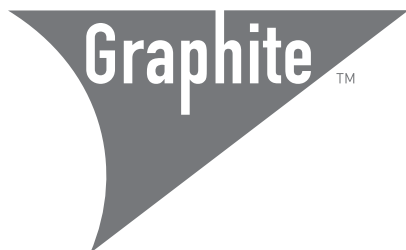

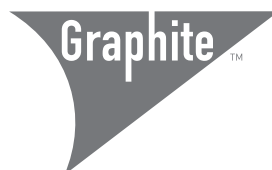
Ellen Gilson Voth
